School Fee	Fee Purpose	Authorized Range
School Supplies	School supplies are consumable supplies that will be used in the classroom. Examples include: paper, pencils, folders, and other individual student items.	\$33-\$50
Student Device Usage	Each FirstLine student will be issued a chromebook device to be taken home and used for school work. This usage fee represents this device as part of a student's supplies for the year.	\$35-\$40
School Uniform Shirt	Each FirstLine School has an individualized school uniform shirt. This represents the approximate cost of the school uniform shirt. All other components of the uniform can be bought at multiple vendors in the city with a wide variety of pricing options.	\$15-\$25
PreK & Kindergarten Promotion Fee	The Kindergarten Promotion Fee pays for end of year parties and a week of experiences.	\$25-\$35
8th Grade Promotion Fee	The 8th Grade Promotion Fee pays for end of year parties, a week of experiences, and promotion event rentals.	\$25-\$50

End Of Year Trips **Optional**	At the end of each school year, grade-levels may elect to take a large, end of the year trip. Sometimes, these trips are overnight and outside of the city, and they have a higher cost. The fee helps to cover the cost of transportation, lodging, and food on these extended trips. Grade-levels may engage in fundraising for the end of the year trips to help reduce the actual cost. The costs for end of year trips are announced at the beginning of the school year, and payment plans are offered.	PreK - 4th: \$55 5th & 6th: \$275 7th & 8th: \$550
Extracurricular Activities **Optional**	The Extracurricular Activities fee is optional but covers the cost of band uniforms, team uniforms and gear.	\$120 - \$165
8th Grade Swag Fee **Optional**	The 8th Grade Swag Fee is optional and pays for items exclusive for 8th graders. Example includes: Class t-shirt, class sweatshirt, etc.	Items can be purchased per item. If all items are purchased, the maximum amount is \$130.
Festivals / Parties **Optional**	Throughout the year, schools host 2-4 festivals and parties each year, such as Fall Fest or Water Day. The fees cover the cost of the event.	Maximum Per Event: \$10
Field Trips **Optional**	During the school year, a variety of field trips are scheduled to enrich the student experience at the school. Field trip fees R

Repairs To Damaged Devices	FirstLine Schools provides technological devices to use for instruction. If a student willfully damages a technological device, students may be charged for repair or replacement of the device. Willful damage is defined as damage caused intentionally or by use inconsistent with the equipment's intended function. i.e. using a tablet as a frisbee. Price will depend on the item needing repairs/replacement.	Cost of replacement/repair; Maximum: \$110
Library Book Replacement	Library book replacement fees may be charged if books are lost or willfully damaged. A fee is charged to help subsidize the cost of replacement. If a student willfully damages a book, students may be charged for repair or replacement of the book. Willful damage is defined as damage caused intentionally or by use inconsistent with the book's intended function. i.e. intentionally tearing pages from a book. Price will depend on the book needing repair/replacement.	Cost of the book; Maximum: \$11
